The College of New Jersey (TCNJ) has been offering Certification and Masters degree programs to international educators since 1981 and has graduated thousands of international school teachers and administrators in that time.

Performance Learning Systems (PLS) has been offering online graduate courses for almost ten years and on-site graduate courses for almost 40 years. PLS supports the integration of 21st century skills into all aspects of teaching and learning.

TCNJ and PLS have been partners since 2004, with PLS offering required classes in TCNJ's programs for international teachers. Now TCNJ and PLS are partnering to offer a Cohort Master of Education degree in Elementary or Secondary Education. Students can complete a concentration in 21st Century Curriculum, Differentiated Instruction, Literacy, Classroom Management, or Middle School Math and Science.

Students who also wish to earn **State of New Jersey teacher certification** may be able to do so upon completing the M.Ed. with specific online electives and two additional courses. This must be arranged with the help of an academic advisor.
